Dear ENERGY STAR® Data Center Storage Partner or Other Interested Stakeholder,

With this letter, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is finalizing the amendments to the ENERGY STAR Data Center Storage test method. This amendment enables manufacturers to test products that support File I/O storage functions entirely or as an additional capability. Currently certified products will not need to be retested to maintain their ENERGY STAR certification.

EPA received comments regarding the Draft Version 1.1 specification proposal, particularly on the effective date. After consideration of these comments, EPA is publishing the revised test method and will release the Version 1.1 specification on May 21, 2018. The intent of this timeline is to allow adequate time for brand owners to test new File I/O based storage products to the updated Version 1.1 specification prior to it becoming effective.
