- If you previously provided incentive information and have mid-year updates, please send in those updates.
- For all others, please review the data on the [ENERGY STAR Rebate Finder](#) by entering a zip code in your service territory and make sure all your incentive information is still accurate and complete.

NOTE: For 2021, EPA has added additional options for incentive types to include

- A call-out for utility online marketplaces if program sponsors wish to provide their customers with direct urls to their marketplaces
- Building envelope products, which include: windows, doors, skylights, storm windows, insulation, and air sealing products

Please review all incentive type and provide information for **all products eligible for an ENERGY STAR certification and all incentive types**. Please provide one row in incentive data for each incentive type for each product.

Please submit your information no later than Monday, July 6!

3. 2020 Coordination with the Consortium for Energy Efficiency

EPA and the Consortium for Energy Efficiency (CEE) each gather data annually from energy efficiency program sponsors for different objectives and audiences. In 2021, we are coordinating to avoid duplicative requests for program details. Data received by EPA in the coming months will be shared with CEE, and used to populate their program summaries. CEE will collect additional program details not encompassed in this data request.
