Dear Displays Partners, EPA-recognized laboratories, EPA-recognized certification bodies, and Other Interested Parties:

The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has a clarification to part of the Version 5.1 ENERGY STAR® specification for Displays that reference Tier 2 requirements. As indicated in the Version 6.0 specification revision <u>launch letter</u> released in December 2010, the Version 6.0 specification revision will supersede the Tier 2 Version 5.1 requirements scheduled to take effect on October 30, 2011. Following a number of recent inquiries on Tier 2 requirements, EPA would like to clarify that the Tier 2 requirements have been removed and will not go into effect.

The exchange of ideas and information between EPA and stakeholders is critical to the success of ENERGY STAR.
