**Subject:** Energy Star Requirements for All-in-Ones Proposal

It has come to VIZIO's attention that an update to Energy Star requirements (V6.0) is in Draft 3 stage. As a manufacturer of All-in-One (AlO) desktop computers, we encourage the EPA to set differentiated requirements for AlOs versus traditional desktop computers. Many AlOs (including VIZIO's) use notebook class components due to constraints on Industrial Design, space and to minimize heat dissipation. The one exception would be the LCD panel as these tend to be LED LCD Monitor class displays due to the size requirements > 18" diagonal. Due to the fact that notebook class components are being used, AlOs traditional provide a different capabilities and functions from a traditional desktop (such as the lack of expandability outside of USB). Differentiated categorization will help level the playing field and help drive energy efficiency in each category. Without this, it will be too easy for AlOs to qualify under ES standards for desktop computers. Please feel free to reach out to me if you have further questions.
